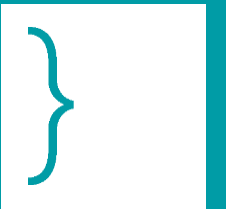

# What's new in the Agylia LMS?

## Learner portal accessibility enhancements

To ensure your learner portal is fully accessible for all, the Agylia LMS has been enhanced to ensure it completely conforms to the WCAG AA accessibility standard. You may notice some minor UI updates and layout changes.

## Team leader dashboard

Now allows managers to drill down the hierarchy in the dashboard. If a direct report also has staff reporting to them, they can see information of their reports.

## Enhanced User Administrator role

Previously, those with a User Administrator role were unable to add new user accounts to the LMS and could only maintain existing accounts. The role has now been enhanced to enable the bulk creation of new users.

## Enhanced Content Administrator role

The Content Administrator role can now be restricted to prevent users with the role from viewing user details. Content Administrator are still able to manage targeting based on groups or OUs in the usual way, however the Users tab is removed.

# What's new in the Agylia LMS?

## Ability to CC and BCC in email notifications

Email templates (both system-level and item-level) can now be configured to automatically CC or BCC any other email addresses.

## Email notifications for Line Managers

Admins can now CC or BCC a learner's Line Manager using the email notification templates.

## 'Did not attend' reports

Learners who did not attend an event/session will be marked as 'not attended' in reports.



# What's new in the Agylia LMS?

## Multiple and delegated approvers

Approvers can now delegate their approvals to other specified users, either indefinitely or for a defined time period. This is useful when the approver knows they will be away. To cater for unexpected absences, admins can now also delegate the approvals for specific users to other users.

## Updates to User / Group / OU selection format

The format of several picker fields in the Administration portal have been updated to make it easier to identify the currently selected set of users, groups, or OUs, and to quickly remove unwanted items from the selected set.

## Enrolment cancellation reason

When learners cancel their enrolment, they're able to add the cancellation reason. The cancellation reason now also appears in the associated email notifications and reports.

# What's new in the Agylia LMS?

## Enrolment rejection reason

When an approver rejects an enrolment, they're able to add the rejection reason. The rejection reason now also appears in associated email notifications and reports.

## Use of cookies

To enhance security, the learner portal now places cookies on a learner's device to store information about the learners' current session. The cookies are essential for correct function of the learner portal. As such, no options for opting out of their use are presented to the learner. As a result, you may wish to update any Privacy Policies you have associated with your learner portal, to include information about the cookies used.
